

BCLS + AED Provider Course (Public Access Defibrillator)

The BCLS+AED Provider Course (Public Access Defibrillator) combines both elements of Basic Cardiac Life Support (BCLS) and Automated External Defibrillator (AED) into one complete course.

A BCLS+AED Provider Certificate will be awarded by Parkway College, accredited by The Singapore Resuscitation and First Aid Council (SRFAC) and is valid for 2 years.


