

Bachelor of Science (Honours) Optometry and Clinical Practice

Course Description

The BSc (Hons) Optometry and Clinical Practice is a 360 credit honours degree, designed as a two-year 240 credit part-time programme for qualified students who will be admitted through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). The programme is approved by OOB under the list of 'Displayable Additional Qualifications'.

This programme is offered in 3 stages and delivers the same learning outcomes as the programme in UK. Stage 2 and 4 are conducted in Singapore while Stage 3 (practical modules) is conducted at Aston University, UK.

Course Objectives

The programme has been designed to provide qualified students in Singapore with an accelerated route to a UK degree in Optometry and also allow them access to the teaching and clinical resources of a leading UK Optometry school.

Course Structure

- Duration: 2 years
- Total Curriculum Hours: 2400 hours
- Course Delivery: 4 hours per day, 3 days per week

• Mode of Delivery: Lectures (Virtual Learning Environment), Workshop/Seminars, Tutorials, Practical, Coursework Assignments and Assessments.

- OC3PCP Clinical Practice (non-condonable)

Stage 4 (Parkway College, Singapore)

- OC3PAE Anterior Eye Conditions
- OC3PBP Binocular Vision and Paediatrics
- OC3PRM Evidence Based Practice, Research Methods
- OC3PLV Professional, Occupational and Low Vision
- OC3PPE Posterior Eye and General Ophthalmology

Who Should Attend

Optometists with a Diploma in Optometry, who are interested in pursuing a Bachelor Degree in Optometry.

Entry Requirements

Applicants must be at least 18 years old, and have all of the following:

- A Diploma in Optometry from Singapore Polytechnic, Ngee Ann Polytechnic or Parkway College with GPA 2.0 and above.
- A qualified Optometrist license (Full, provisional, temporary) from Optometrists and Opticians Board (OOB), Singapore.
- A GCE O-level credit in English language or an IELTS score of 6.5 overall with a minimum of 6.0 in each section.
- Applicants must be Singapore or Malaysia passport holders who can meet the UK Visa requirement for the stage 3 compulsory UK residence training.

Candidates who do not meet the full entry requirements may be considered on a case-by-case basis subjected to Aston University's approval.

Bachelor of Science (Honours) Optometry and Clinical Practice, awarded by Aston University, United Kingdom.


