Course Description

This Bachelor of Science degree programme (with Honours) from the University of Hertfordshire is offered in Singapore by Parkway College. Entry Requirements

Eligibility and Academic Requirements

- Candidates must be a Singapore Citizen or Singapore Permanent Resident, be 18 years old and above, AND have at least:
 - A minimum of 5 GCE 'O' level passes with English, Mathematics and Science OR Completion of Polytechnic Foundation Programme with at least C+ for English modules, AND
 - GCE 'A' level (or equivalent) with at least one science at 'A' level, with an overall UCAS Tariff System score of 120 points, OR
 - Candidates with a Degree or Polytechnic Diploma in the Science field, with at least a GPA of 2.5 are also eligible to apply.

Health and Other Requirements

- All candidates are required to attend and pass a selection panel interview before they can be enrolled into the programme.
- Due to the unique requirements of healthcare professions, all candidates should be free from physical handicap and successful candidates are required to undergo and pass a medical examination.

Submit a completed application form, together with a personal statement, to Parkway College.
