Course Description

The Diploma in Nursing course provides students with professional skills and knowledge to prepare them for a career in nursing. It also provides students with an evidence based education to meet the challenges in modern nursing. Students learn from current hospital practitioners with different nursing specialty to gain an understanding of the healthcare environment.

Course Objectives

Upon completion of this course, students will gain the professional foundation in behavioural, biological and nursing sciences. The 3 years course also aim to develop students to be a reflective and knowledgeable nurse with empathy and heart in serving.

Course Structure

- Duration: 36 months on full-time basis
- Total curriculum hours: 3500
- Course delivery: delivered over 6 semesters
- Mode of delivery: lectures, tutorials, case-studies discussions, presentations, assignments, experiential learning, practical sessions, self-directed and e-learning.

Academic Requirements

Local Students who are at least 16 years old:

GCE "O" Level students with minimum of 5 GCE "O" Level credits:

- English Language (Grade 1 to 7)
- Elementary or Additional Mathematics (Grade 1 to 6)
- 1 science subject (Grade 1 to 6)
- 2 other subjects (Grade 1 to 6)

The results attained from GCE "O" level examinations can be combined from no more than 2 attempts.

NITEC graduates:

- Enrolled nurses with GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Enrolled nurses with 3 years post-enrolment work experience and a bridging course certificate acquired from Nanyang Polytechnic or Ngee Ann Polytechnic.
- NITEC and Higher NITEC in related fields

International Students who are at least 16 years old:
