

ADVISORY NOTE TO PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS

This advisory note is for a prospective student of the BSc (Hons) in Diagnostic Radiography and Imaging Course.

Programme Information

- 1) The BSc (Hons) in Diagnostic Radiography and Imaging Course is a 3-year full-time programme offered by the University of Hertfordshire through Parkway College of Nursing and Allied Health.
- 2) This course is accepted by the Allied Health Professions Council (AHPC) in Singapore.
- 3) Clinical placement is an essential component of the course in order to meet the required learning outcomes of the course for graduation.

Compliance for Clinical Placement

Students should adhere to the following requirements throughout the course of study:

- 1) Students are not allowed to have tattoo and body art which can be seen when the uniform is worn during clinical placement.
- 2) Students are not allowed to wear hijab or head scarf during clinical placement for infection control purposes.
- 3) Students should note that the course fee is a significant amount which is payable before the start of every semester. Upon payment of the course fee for each semester, students will then be allowed to proceed with clinical placement and classes for the semester.
